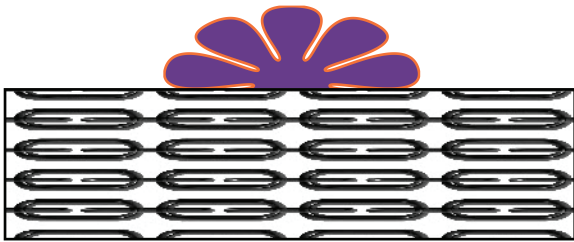

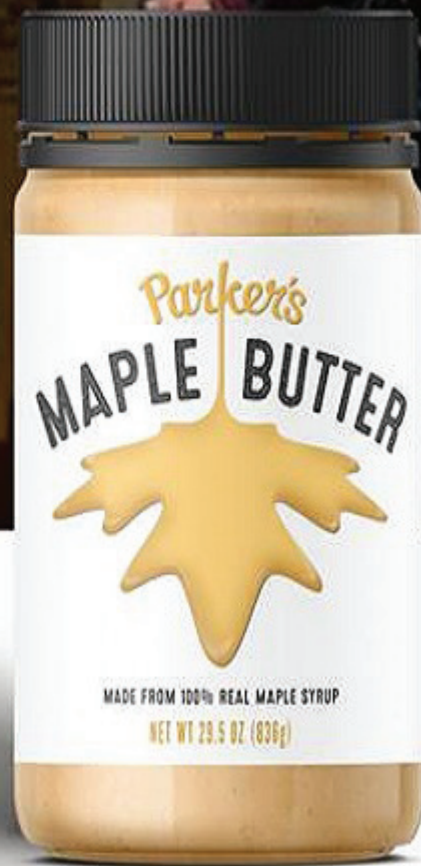

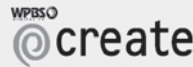

Remeber Pearl Harbor
Airs Tuesday, December 6th at 6:30pm



Narrated by veteran Hollywood actor Tom Selleck, REMEMBER PEARL HARBOR chronicles the personal stories of veterans and citizens who witnessed the surprise attack by the Japanese on the American Pacific Fleet on December 7, 1941, launching the United States into World War II. Using archival footage and photos and graphics, the documentary shows in detail the bombings on Oahu, along with the fiery explosion of the USS Arizona, the sinking of the USS Oklahoma, and the attacks on Hickam Field, as well as on other parts of the island. REMEMBER PEARL HARBOR documents the 75th anniversary, the tragic events and the courageous acts of those who were in or near Pearl Harbor on that day. The film includes first-person accounts from sailors, airmen, soldiers and civilians, including Lou Center, USS Arizona; James Downing, USS Virginia; Vernon Carter, US Army Air Corps, Hickam Field; and Barbara Kotinek, who was just six years old at the time and lived within eyesight of Pearl Harbor.

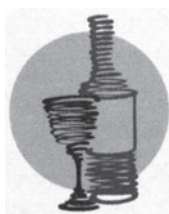

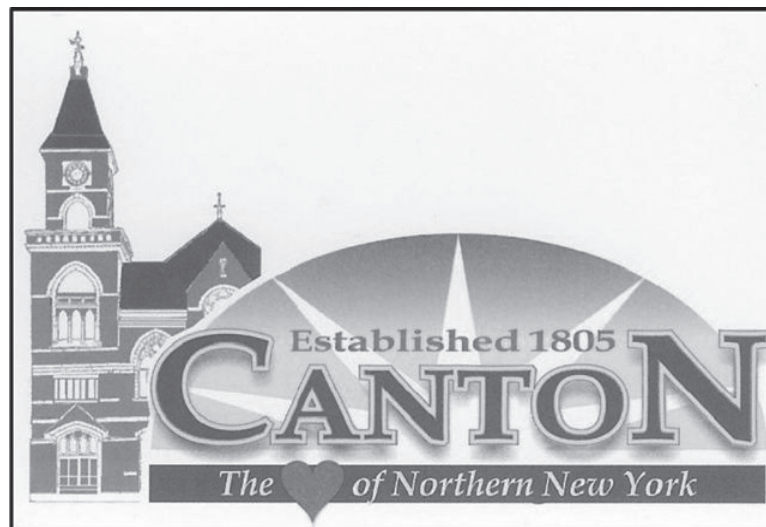

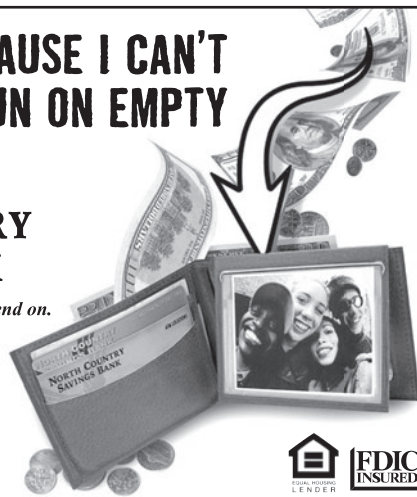

St. John's Conservatory Theater's 'Christmas Carol' Tradition

Annual Dickens' Classic Returns Bigger, Better Than Ever

St. John's Conservatory Theater presents their annual holiday production of BRAZILLIA R. KREEP'S CHRISTMAS CAROL, a fully staged theatrical adaptation of the Charles Dickens' iconic classic A CHRISTMAS CAROL. With book, music, and lyrics by award-winning writer and composer Richard O'Donnell (under his nom de plum Brazillia R. Krep), this awe-inspiring, side-splitting, toe-tapping musical promises to be a real treat for the entire family.

Returning to an imaginary Victorian town in 1843, Ye Ole St. Lawrence, where a miserly Ebenezer Scrooge, played by O'Donnell, "Bah Humbugs" the Christmas spirit to the dismay of his co-worker, family and friends. Comical ghosts from his past, present, and future appear to dance, sing, and even scare some sense into the ill-tempered man. With a large cast of locals, celebrated costumes, and magnificent sets, BRAZILLIA R. KREEP'S CHRISTMAS CAROL is a sight to behold.

"This is Scrooge meets Saturday Night Live," remarks director Christopher Dwyer. "It's bigger, better and funnier than ever with over a dozen expertly orchestrated songs and a super talented cast hailing from all over the North Country. Technically speaking, things have improved considerably over the years. The multi-leveled stage has been rebuilt, a new lighting system implemented, and microphones installed assuring a real state-of-the-art theatrical experience."

BRAZILLIA R. KREEP'S CHRISTMAS CAROL has over 24 cast members and stars O'Donnell as Scrooge, Stephen Chambers as Jacob Marley, Tessa Harper as Thelma Plum (Ghost of Been There Done That), Angela Dwyer as Matilda Pift (Ghost of Christmas Presents), Hailey Weber as Elvira Frippl (Scrooge's old love interest), Brandon Bogart as Fezziwig, Rachel O'Donnell as Mrs. Fezziwig. The Cratchit Family stars Christopher Dwyer as Bob, Shelly Murdock as Emily, Myah Myers as Martha, Cadence Payne as Bella, and Dee Bellinger as Tiny Tina. The Street Urchins are portrayed by Sloane Ryan as Nipper, Jillian LeBel as Cager, Meghan Gardner as Dolly, Macy Murdock as Scraps, Grant Brunet as Rusty, Chris Rodriguez as Spider, Caroline Silver as Dustbin, and Sophia Silver as St-epintime. Carolers star Rachel O'Donnell as Mrs. Sparkles, Brandon Bogart as Mr. Sparkles, Madison Miller as Mary Sparkles, Delia Payne as Lizzy Sparkles, Cadence Payne as Ethel Sparkles, Myah Myers as Bessie Sparkles, Gabriella Ott as Florence Sparkles, and Philomena Bullock as Dandelion.

"As we do every year, we've recreated the principal wardrobes," says Costume Designer Karen Fischbeck. "They're more authentic and spectacular than ever. We have a crew of five hard working artists such as the very talented Ann Losurdo and Heron Hetzler. Each seamstress adds their own unique vision to the actor's ambiance. After costumes are adjusted, wigs and make-up applied, it's simply thrilling to watch the character's come to life

onstage."

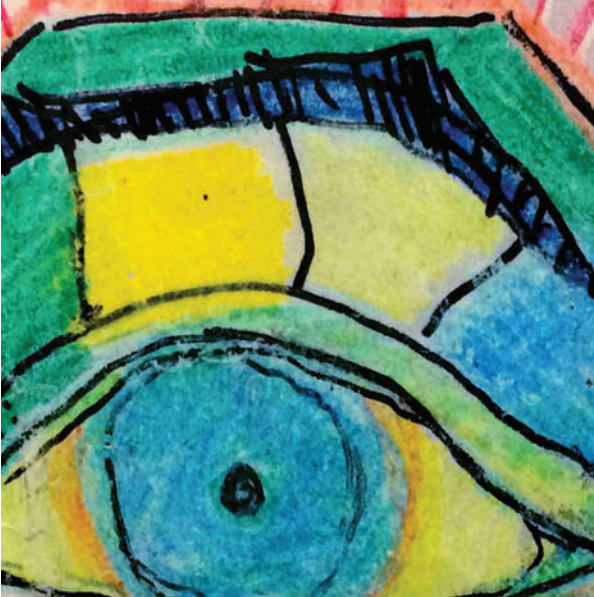

Dust To Gold

by *Cris Jacobs (2016) American Showplace Music*

The first thing that caught my attention when listening to *Dust To Gold*, the new CD from Cris Jacobs, was his voice, so rich and earthy. And the words from the first song, "The Devil or Jesse James," are pure poetry—that's the second thing I noticed: "Call me a churchyard sinner/ Call me a graveyard saint/ Call me anything that you want to/ Call me the devil or Jesse James." There's something lonesome, haunted, and nearly heartbroken at the core of "The Devil or Jesse James." That stark moonlight guitar glares down on the night road, spotlighting the narrator running through Cajun country or down to Mexico, running from something, determined to get away from whatever it is; call him what you want, he doesn't care—he's gone. Another thing that stands out is the variety of the music. "Hallelujah Hustler" could be a gospel-fla-

vored radio song. "Jack the Whistle and the Hammer" is a roadhouse stomp, followed on the CD by the stately, plaintive "Cold Carolina." "Bone Digger" is a straight-out rocker with some nasty, howling guitar. "Delivery Man," a catchy soulful love song, really grows on you. "Turn into Gold" is a dynamic slowed-down relentless rock meditation. On "Little Dreamer," Cris is joined on vocals by his wife Kat Jacobs, who discovered that she was pregnant just as the band started to record the album; together they sing to their unborn: "It's a blink of an eye, this life/ Tiny grains in sands of time/ So tie your purposes on wings/ And fly to the heavens with the grace and courage of a thousand kings." Then we have the steady and measured "Break your Fall." "Shine your Weary Light" is a fluid funky rocker, featuring straight-ahead drums and guitar. The CD closes with "Leaving Charm City,"

sweet and sad.

A word about the band: they are so good that you hardly notice them. What I mean is that whatever they play fits in perfectly with the mood of each individual song. I'm talking about Todd Herrington on bass, Dusty Ray Simmons on drums, and John Ginty on various keyboards; Jonathan Sloane plays slide guitar on a few songs. These guys are there when you need them

and not when you don't. Cris Jacobs of course excels on vocals and guitar, plus he wrote all the songs, with Ginty helping out on "Delivery Man."

This guy's the real thing. Buy the music or catch the band live—this December they're playing a number of shows between Washington DC and Brooklyn, New York. Check the website for dates and locations.
