Study Blue	Create course specific flash cards, review and assess	On-line access, free, ease of use
Edmodo	Course ware like	On-line access, free, use varies in complexity
Showme	Interactive white board screen capture. Mini study movies	On-line access, free, ease of use. Can be both a tool for teachers and students
Book creator	Create media enriched story books	Simple tool palettes and intuitive interface
Instaframe	Can use gathered images or camera photos to create topic related vignettes	Quick project, good results
Smart Recorder	Create and edit sounds for stand alone projects or for inclusion in other projects	Simple interface and all in one package. Limited to 3 minutes
Toontastic	Create animated stories related to topics, include some multimedia	Free version is limited
